



## **BHS CHALLENGE RIDES 2012 – A GREAT WAY TO RAISE FUNDS FOR OUR BELOVED EQUINES**

BHS Challenge Rides offer you the chance to experience the adventure of a lifetime while raising vital funds for the British Horse Society's welfare work. Challengers can choose between riding 5000 meters up in the Peruvian Andes, exploring the Rajasthan region of India or riding across the volcanic moonscape of Iceland. Alternatively you can ride through the Rose City of Petra in Jordan or gallop over the vast plains of Mongolia. The Spartacus Trail ride in Bulgaria was an adventurous new challenge ride for 2011 which travelled through three mountain ranges to the border of Greece and this is a ride which will be offered to advanced riders in 2013.

In **2012** a brand new ride is being launched in the NE of Spain, The Catalonia Trail **10-16 June** which is a beautiful ride through pine forests and the national park, rising onto the Pyrenees. Other rides available in 2012 are the Inca Challenge in Peru, **20 May -2 June**, The Viking Challenge in Iceland **18-25 August** and the ride in Rajasthan, Riding with Kings **6-16 October**. Places are strictly limited on all rides.

So, if you are looking for a new challenge and want to do something to show your support for British horses, saddle up and enjoy a life-changing experience. This really does put the fun in Fundraising!

Every penny raised by the BHS Challenge Rides is spent funding welfare work and helps to provide a nationwide network of welfare officers investigating thousands of cases of horse neglect and abuse annually.
