

Wind Farm Familiarisation Ride

at

Whitelee Windfarm, Moor Rd, Eaglesham, Glasgow G76 0QQ

1 July 2017 , 10am - 4pm

BHS Scotland runs a guided pleasure and familiarisation ride at Whitelee Windfarm, following the Lochgoin Circuit. This 13km route sticks to the main windfarm tracks along the way-marked Lochgoin Circuit route, taking in spectacular views over Lochgoin Reservoir and beyond. This pleasant ride is a perfect way to familiarise your horse with the great riding available at windfarms. You need to be able to negotiate a few gates. Some of the tracks around Whitelee Windfarm are relatively rough and therefore some may not find the ride appropriate for horses that are barefoot or for horses with sensitive hooves, however the majority of horses would manage these tracks. The guided ride is an ideal environment to allow your horses to become familiar with such wind turbines.



Conditions of Entry:

1. All riders must wear hard hats with a fixed harness to comply with the 2017 BHS guidelines - Due to a change by the European Commission regarding EN1384 and BSEN1384 no longer being an accepted standard, all hats which ONLY meet the standard EN1384 or BSEN1384, and do not comply with another accepted standard WILL NOT be permitted for use. Hats which bear EN1384 or BSEN1384 ALONG WITH another accepted standard, will be permitted. For example, BSEN1384 & PAS015 (1998 or 2011) along with the Kitemark or Inspec IC mark will be acceptable, but not BSEN1384 on its own.
2. Riders aged 14 and under must be accompanied on the ride by a responsible and suitably experienced adult.
3. All horses / ponies to be 4 years or over.
4. Instructions of organisers, officials and stewards must be followed to promote the safety of everyone present.
5. **Reflective clothing must be worn on horse and rider.**
6. All riders are expected to follow the Scottish Outdoor Access Code and must expect to open and close gates on the route.
7. Please leave the parking area as you found it—don't muck out your trailer or lorry in the parking area, and take your dung home with you. Thank you!
8. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor British Horse Society Scotland nor the Whitelee Windfarm nor any agent, employee, representative of these bodies accepts liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
